
81st Legislature Regular Session

The Texas Legislature convened for regular session January 13, 2009. As of the date of this newsletter, 970 House Bills and 604 Senate Bills have been filed. (February 2)



The District will continue to monitor Legislative activity utilizing Telicon, an online tracking system. Additionally, the Texas Alliance of Groundwater Districts, to which the District belongs, will have a steady presence in Austin.

WATER LEVELS

Ronnie Moore has been actively measuring water levels throughout the District. As we stand, the average decline is about 2.52'. Last year's rainfall totals were below average, therefore, providing us with very little recharge. Ronnie will continue to collect measurements. These levels will be available on our website in an interactive format. In other words, you can click on the well and see the historic levels for a particular well. The feature is still in its early stages but will get better with time.

Doug Coker from the Texas Water Development Board will also be in the District measuring the wells that we don't have on our list. He will share all data collected with the District. He will be calling landowners in the next few weeks to set up dates and times to visit the property. 

RAINFALL 2008


