Counties to Map Water Strategy

Mayor H. L. Gober, who was appointed chairman of a group to establish guidelines for the Hickory Underground Water District meeting with the San Angelo city government, has called a meeting for Saturday in Brady.

Gober said he contacted every judge and mayor in Concho, Menard, Mason, San Saba and Kimble counties to sit in on the meeting.

The meeting, which will be held at

the Heart of Texas Civic Center, will be to coordinate plans for the meeting of the Hickory Underground Water District on March 14, to vote on whether or not to give San Angelo permission to drill more wells.

This meeting will not be open to the public, but is for those counties and cities which will be affected by the request of San Angelo to drill 13 more wells in the Hickory Aquifer.
